

A DEVELOPMENT OF THE STUDENT EVALUATION SYSTEM OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATION BASED ON COLLABORATIVE EVALUATION.

ABSTRACT

The objective of this study was to develop the student Evaluation System of Cooperative Education . Research procedures consisted of 6 steps: System Analysis, System Synthesis, System design, System Verification, System Improvement and System Implementation.

The research results could be concluded as follow:

1. The model of the performance appraisal system of Cooperative Education Student Consisted of 4 dimension : Objective of System , Principle of System , Construction of System and System Improvement.
2. The Construction of System dimension consisted of 4 basic dimension : Input , Process , Output and Feedback
3. The Input dimension consisted of Appraisal objective , Performance indicators and criteria , appraisers and appraises.
4. The Process dimension consisted of Performance Appraisal Planning , Appraisal Instruments , Collecting the Performance data , Analysis and evaluation the Performance.
5. The Outputs dimension consisted of Results of performance appraisal of Cooperative Education Students.
6. The Feedback dimension consisted of Feedback for the advisor student and Cooperative students.
